

# LBBC Camp Guidelines 2020

Please review the camp guidelines that were approved by the LBBC board.

## Camp Arrival/Check In (Sunday Afternoon)

- Parents/Guardians will wait in their vehicle until a camp staff member directs them to the pavilion to register.
  - Campers will have their temperature checked and if they have a fever of 100.4 or higher, they will not be eligible to stay.
- LBBC is encouraging campers to bring their own set of facemasks/coverings. Let a staff member know if your children need one provided.
- Parents/Guardians and campers will check in and sign the COVID19 guidelines and waiver.
- After check in is complete, parents/guardians will return to their vehicle and campers will take their camping items to their assigned cabin.

NOTE: Parents/Guardians are welcome to use the restroom in the sports shed (sanitizing will take place throughout the day) but will not be allowed to enter any of the other buildings including mess hall, chapel or cabins.

## New Camp Daily Routine/Restrictions

- PODS-Campers will be grouped in pods at check-in
  - Will include entire cabin-NO bed sharing/sitting in common bunks and sleep head to foot.
  - Will sit together in mess hall and chapel-seating destination will be posted for each pod
    - Will be kept separated (6 feet apart) from other pods while in buildings and social distancing will be practiced with pods as much as possible.
- All staff and campers will have their temperature checked daily
  - Campers with a fever of 100.4 or higher will be required to be quarantined (in cabin 7) immediately and their parents will be required to pick them up ASAP
  - Staff with a fever of 100.4 or higher will be required to leave immediately
  - All camper's parents/guardians will be notified that someone has demonstrated COVID19 symptoms.
- All meals will be served on disposable paper/plastic products
  - Director's job is to ensure the wellbeing of the campers are met, adequate hydration!
  - Campers are encouraged to bring a water bottle that can be used to fill up at designated pod locations.
- All food items will be served by cooking staff/counselors and as much as possible served behind the serving wall
  - Campers will not be allowed in serving area for ANY reason or time including storing and retrieving drinks/food from the coolers or assisting with cleaning or serving.
- Mess hall and bathrooms and all common areas will be sanitized three times a day

## Clarification

Any camper that leaves the campgrounds for ANY reason will NOT be allowed to return.

No visitors will be allowed on campgrounds after check-in, the only exceptions are if they are necessary for the director to maintain a camp session. (Example, someone designated to bring food or supplies, outside speakers or someone to do handiwork).

- Each director will provide this list of necessary visitors (exemption list) to the board.
- Any parents/guardians contacted for a baptism will be allowed into the pool area only
  - Everyone on the exemption list will have their temperature checked every day when they arrive on campgrounds and if they have a fever of 100.4 or higher, they will be required to leave immediately.

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#### JACKSON COUNTY MANDATE

Jackson County mandates (effective July 1<sup>st</sup> with no communicated end date) that everyone age five and over wears facemasks/coverings both in and outdoors with the following exceptions: persons with a medical condition, mental health conditions or disability that prevents wearing a covering.
